

Digital Poster Presentation Guidelines

Poster session at ACEM 2017 in Bali, Indonesia, will be presented as digital poster presentation. All posters are distributed on two days during the conference. Please see the schedule for further information.

In the digital presentation, authors should present their posters on Digital Display (43 inch vertical screen) for 15 minutes. The authors should prepare the presented poster in an Image file (**jpg or png**) with minimum resolution of **150 dpi and W 2000 pixels**. Please be sure to maintain the aspect ratio during file conversion.

Poster Guidelines

In preparing your poster, please note the following points:

Please ensure that your display will fit within these parameters.

- Poster layout: Portrait (**Letter or A4 size**)
- Title should be in bold. Author affiliations and e-mail addresses should be included.
- Text: a poster should be easily readable from a distance of 1–2 meters, with a line spacing of 1.5 or 2. Authors should also pay attention to the following points:
- font : Times New Roman or Arial
- Headings should be 25% larger than normal text. Bold or other colors may be used.

Suggested font sizes are:

- Main title: 14 pt (bold, upper case),
- Author: 11 pt (bold, title case),
- Affiliation(s): 10 pt (normal, title case),
- Email address: 10 pt (bold),
- Subheading: 12 pt (bold, upper case),
- Body of text: 11 pt (normal), and
- Smaller fonts may be used in citations and acknowledgement.

Your poster should include:

Title: project title.

Authors: your name, faculty advisor's name, names of collaborators and department.

Introduction (or Objectives).

Methods.

Results (or Findings).

Discussion.

Conclusions.

Acknowledgments (if necessary).

References

Suggestions for selecting colors and fonts :

Use only 2 or 3 colors in the poster as too many colors can be distracting.

Select font colors and background colors to maximize contrast: A dark font on a light background is more easily read than vice versa.

The amount of text should be kept to a minimum and each block of text should include no more than a few sentences. To maximize your space efficiency, remove information that is not relevant to the topic.

To emphasize a point, use bold or italics rather than underlining as underlined words can be more difficult to read.

Role of the poster presenter

Provide **flash presentation file**.

Answer questions about the research.
